Wet Season Evaluation Application Procedures

This evaluation does not constitute approval of an on-site sewage system permit.

Procedure for Obtaining a Wet Season Evaluation:

1. Complete and submit the Wet Season Evaluation application and fee.
 - Application for a Wet Season Evaluation must be submitted by February 15th. The wet season evaluation is usually completed by NETCHD staff during the period of March, April, and May. If an early or late snow melt occurs, the three-month evaluation period may be adjusted.
 - A site map must be included with the application submittal. The site map must be accurate and include the proposed locations of monitoring ports and distances to property lines.
2. Location and Installation of Monitoring Ports
 - The proposed location of the monitoring ports shall be evaluated and approved by NETCHD Staff prior to installation.
 - A minimum of two (2) monitoring ports shall be prepared, one (1) in the primary drainfield area and one (1) in the reserve drainfield area. NETCHD staff will review the application and if site/soil conditions necessitate additional monitoring ports, NETCHD staff will communicate the additional monitoring port requirements to the applicant.
 - Monitoring Port Construction:
 - Monitoring ports shall be constructed of four inch (4") or larger solid PVC pipe that has been slotted or perforated throughout the anticipated zone of saturation. The PVC pipe must be wrapped with geotextile fabric and secured with duct tape.
 - Monitoring ports are to be installed into the horizon to be monitored a minimum of twelve inches (12") below the depth needed to meet minimum vertical separation requirements.
 - A small amount of gravel is to be placed in the bottom of the hole to prevent silt from sealing the bottom of the hole.
 - The below grade section of pipe shall be backfilled with porous material, such as coarse sand or pea gravel.
 - Slightly mound the soil around the monitoring port to direct precipitation and surface run-off away from the pipe.
 - The monitoring port shall be capped with a slip style cap. The top of the pipe shall be slotted to allow easy removal of the cap or screw type caps may be used.
 - Vehicle access to the monitoring ports shall be maintained by the applicant, and unless otherwise approved, should be within 100 feet of the monitoring ports. If the monitoring ports are inaccessible at time of a site visit, an additional fee shall be charged at the hourly rate for an additional site visit.

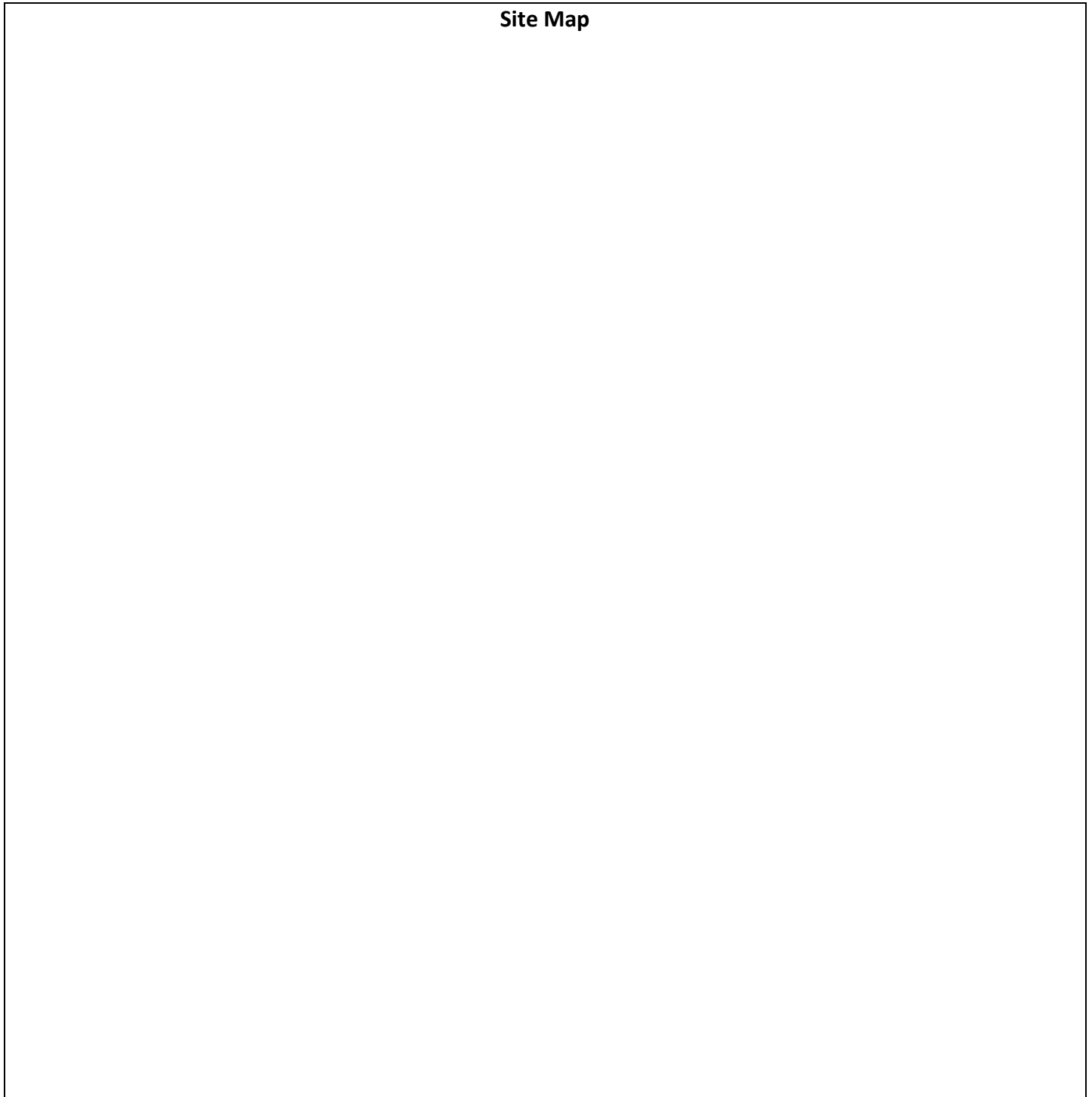
