



## Steps to get tested for COVID-19 in Ferry, Stevens, and Pend Oreille Counties

**FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW:** If you have symptoms of Coronavirus, or have questions about symptoms you may be experiencing, follow the steps below to help protect other people in your home and community.

### Call ahead before visiting your doctor

- If you are short of breath or have chest pain, you need to call your health care provider immediately, or call 911.
- If you call your health care provider...**DO NOT** go to the clinic, or other places you could expose others to the virus. Tell them you are experiencing symptoms or are unsure if you should be tested.
